SUMMARY

Michigan Supreme Court order denying leave to appeal in a consolidated child protective proceeding involving four minors. The Court was not persuaded that the questions presented warranted review, leaving the Court of Appeals judgment undisturbed. The case originated from the Midland County Family Division under a child neglect/abuse docket.
