SUMMARY

This is a dissenting opinion by Justice Mundy of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania concerning the early termination of juvenile delinquency supervision. The dissent argues that terminating supervision solely to permit the juvenile's admission to a treatment program was reversible error because the juvenile remained in need of treatment, supervision, and rehabilitation.
