This document is a statutory Declaration of Domicile form authorized by Section 222.17, Florida Statutes, for individuals establishing Florida as their permanent and predominant home. It requires the declarant to identify their Florida residence, any former residences, and other places of abode, and must be sworn before a notary and filed with the clerk of the circuit court.
