SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the District of Oregon ordered an award of \$8,470.55 in attorney fees to Plaintiff Elizabeth J. LaCroix under the Equal Access to Justice Act. The order directs payment subject to any federal treasury offset and states that no costs or expenses are awarded.

Administration, Defendant. Based upon the Stipulation of the parties, it is ORDERED that
attorney fees in the amount of \$8,470.55 are hereby awarded to Plaintiff, pursuant to the Equal
Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412.

Pursuant to *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 560 U.S. 586, 130 S. Ct. 2521, 2527 (2010), if the Commissioner
confirms that Plaintiff owes no debt to the Government through the federal treasury offset
program, payment of this award shall be made by check made payable and mailed to Plaintiff's

Willamette Street, Eugene, Oregon 97401.

If Plaintiff has such debt, the check for any remaining funds after offset shall be made out to
Plaintiff and mailed to counsel's address provided above. There are no costs or expenses to be
