## Kim v. Hudson

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### SUMMARY

The Intermediate Court of Appeals of Hawai‘i approved the parties’ stipulation to dismiss the appeal with prejudice under Hawai‘i Rules of Appellate Procedure Rule 42(b). The court ordered the parties to bear their own attorneys’ fees and costs.
