Disciplinary Counsel v. Grendell

SUMMARY

The Supreme Court of Ohio considers Timothy Joseph Grendell's application for reinstatement to the practice of law. The court finds that he complied with the applicable suspension order and reinstates him to practice in Ohio.

_____ {¶ 1} This cause came on for further consideration upon the filing of an application for reinstatement by respondent, Timothy Joseph Grendell, Attorney Registration No. 0005827, last known business address in Chardon, Ohio. {¶ 2} The court coming now to consider its order of November 21, 2025, wherein the court, pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(12)(A)(3), suspended respondent from the practice of law for a period of 18 months with 12 months stayed on condition, finds that respondent has complied with that order and with the provisions of Gov.Bar R. V(24). {¶ 3} Therefore, it is ordered by this court that respondent is reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Ohio. {¶ 4} It is further ordered that the clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order as provided for in Gov.Bar R.
