SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the District of Minnesota adopted a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation after finding no clear error and no timely objections. The court dismissed the matter without prejudice under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) and denied the plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis as moot.

No. 5.) No objections have been filed to that R&R in the time permitted.

Absent timely objections, the R&R is reviewed for clear error. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b); *Grinder v. Gammon*, 73 F.3d 793, 795 (8th Cir. 1996). Having reviewed the R&R, no clear error is found. Based on the R&R of the Magistrate Judge, and on all the files, records, and proceedings herein, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1.

The January 6, 2026 Report and Recommendation (Doc. No. 5) is ACCEPTED; 2. This matter is DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B); and 3. Plaintiff Dominique B.'s application to proceed in forma pauperis (Doc. 1 This District has adopted the policy of using only the first name and last initial of any nongovernmental parties in social security appeals such as the present case.
