SUMMARY

The Fourth Court of Appeals of Texas granted the appellant's first motion for an extension of time to file a brief in an accelerated appeal from an order terminating parental rights. The court extended the briefing deadline to January 28, 2014, and referenced Texas appellate and judicial administration rules governing briefing and disposition of SAPCR appeals.
