SUMMARY

The Fourth Court of Appeals of Texas denied a petition for writ of mandamus filed by Joe Guillen, Carolyn Harris, Sidney Hipp, Wayne Holmes, and Shenandoah Church of Christ. The court also denied as moot the relators' motion for temporary relief pending resolution of the mandamus petition.
