1. Whether the court should accept the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation when no timely objections were filed and no clear error was found.
2. Whether the petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 should be denied.

HOLDINGS

1. When no timely objections are filed to a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation, the district court reviews the recommendation for clear error.
2. The petitioner's Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 is denied.

“Petitioner Vidal Licea Morales’s Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (Doc. No. 1) is DENIED.”

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The order contains no substantive facts concerning the underlying habeas claims. It identifies Vidal Licea Morales as the petitioner and Jared Rardin as the respondent and states that Morales filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

United States Magistrate Judge John F. Docherty issued a Report and Recommendation on December 5, 2025. No objections were filed within the permitted period. The district court reviewed the Report and Recommendation for clear error, found none, accepted it, and denied the § 2241 petition.
