Veronica Louise Hudson v. Daniel Lee Hudson

Alaska (July 7, 2023)

SUMMARY

The Alaska Supreme Court reviews a divorce property-division order involving the classification of severance and bonus payments, economic misconduct, the parties' financial conditions, equalization payments, and attorney's fees. The court holds that the superior court improperly classified the payments without examining their specific purposes and clearly erred in analyzing economic misconduct and the parties' financial conditions. It vacates the relevant rulings and remands for further proceedings and reconsideration of the property distribution.
