SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the District of Minnesota accepted a magistrate judge’s Report and Recommendation after finding no clear error and noting that no objections had been filed. The court denied Luis S.R.’s amended petition for a writ of habeas corpus challenging his immigration detention and ordered judgment entered accordingly.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the district court should accept the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation when no timely objections were filed.
2. Whether the amended petition for a writ of habeas corpus should be denied as recommended by the magistrate judge.

HOLDINGS

1. When no timely objections are filed to a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation, the district court reviews the recommendation for clear error.
2. The court accepted the March 26, 2026 Report and Recommendation and denied Luis S.R.'s amended petition for a writ of habeas corpus.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion concerns Luis S.R.'s amended petition for a writ of habeas corpus against federal immigration authorities and related officials. The order does not describe the underlying detention or immigration facts because it resolves the matter by accepting the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation after finding no clear error.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

United States Magistrate Judge Elizabeth Cowan Wright issued a Report and Recommendation on March 26, 2026. After no objections were filed within the permitted period, District Judge Jerry W. Blackwell reviewed the recommendation for clear error, found none, accepted it, and denied the amended habeas petition.
