SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the District of Minnesota accepted a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation after no party objected and the court found no clear error. The court dismissed Shelley Jane Mills's complaint without prejudice for failure to prosecute and directed that judgment be entered.
