SUMMARY

Michigan Supreme Court procedural order granting plaintiff-appellee's motion for an extension of time to file its answer to the application for leave to appeal. The court held the answer would be accepted as timely if submitted by May 26, 2021. No substantive legal issues were decided; the order addresses only appellate procedure and time extensions.
