SUMMARY

The Nevada Supreme Court considered Kevin Antwone Belcher's direct criminal appeal from the Second Judicial District Court in Washoe County. In an order of affirmance filed April 27, 2022, the court affirmed the judgment of conviction and submitted the matter without oral argument.
