SUMMARY

The Fifth Circuit denied rehearing en banc in this criminal case, leaving intact the underlying decision from the Western District of Texas (889 F.2d 1435). The denial of en banc rehearing is a procedural ruling under Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 35 and does not address the merits of the original conviction or sentence. This summary reflects the court's refusal to reconsider the case before the full panel.
