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QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the court should grant appellants' unopposed motion to extend the briefing deadlines and approve the parties' agreed briefing schedule.

KEY QUOTATIONS

“We GRANT the motion and ORDER appellants’ opening brief be filed no later than June 14, 2019, appellees’ response brief be filed no later than August 12, 2019, and appellant’s reply brief be filed no later than September 12, 2019.”

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The parties were engaged in an accelerated appeal. Appellants requested a twenty-nine-day extension for their opening brief, a thirty-nine-day extension for appellees' response brief, and an eleven-day extension for their reply brief. The motion was unopposed.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The matter was on appeal from the 116th Judicial District Court of Dallas County, Texas, in Trial Court Cause No. DC-18-18371. The appellate court considered appellants' unopposed motion to approve an agreed briefing schedule and granted it.
