SUMMARY

The Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals dismissed with prejudice two appeals brought by Vectrus Systems Corporation under Contract No. FA3002-17-C-0001. The Board stated that the disputes had been settled.

1. Whether the settled contract appeals should be dismissed with prejudice.

HOLDINGS

1. Because the disputes had been settled, the Board dismissed ASBCA Nos. 64208-ADR and 64209-ADR with prejudice.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The appeals concerned disputes arising under Contract No. FA3002-17-C-0001. The parties resolved those disputes by settlement.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Vectrus Systems Corporation brought two contract appeals, ASBCA Nos. 64208-ADR and 64209-ADR, under Contract No. FA3002-17-C-0001. The parties settled the disputes, and the Board dismissed both appeals with prejudice.
