The appeal arose from the 224th Judicial District Court of Bexar County, Texas, trial court cause number 2013-CI-15361. The appellee's brief was due September 19, 2018. The appellee filed an unopposed first motion for extension of time, which the court granted, extending the briefing deadline to October 29, 2018.
