SUMMARY

The Sixth Court of Appeals of Texas affirmed the trial court’s orders dismissing claims against Dr. Mark Campbell, Dr. Mark Gibbs and Paris Orthopedic Clinic, P.A., and Dr. Pia Lippincott. The court ordered Angela Hilton, individually and as representative of Barbara Jackson’s estate, to pay the costs of the appeal.

1. Whether the trial court erred by granting the motions to dismiss filed by Dr. Mark Campbell; Dr. Mark Gibbs and Paris Orthopedic Clinic, P.A.; and Dr. Pia Lippincott.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion text provides no substantive factual background concerning the underlying dispute. It states only that the trial court granted motions to dismiss filed by Dr. Mark Campbell; Dr. Mark Gibbs and Paris Orthopedic Clinic, P.A.; and Dr. Pia Lippincott.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Angela Hilton appealed the trial court's orders granting three motions to dismiss. The Court of Appeals found no error in the trial court's orders, affirmed them, and assessed the costs of appeal against Hilton.
