SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Western District of Texas adopted a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation after finding no objections and determining that the recommendation was neither clearly erroneous nor contrary to law. The court granted Freedom Mortgage Corporation's motion to dismiss, dismissed the plaintiff's claims, and closed the case.

Chestney's Report and Recommendation (R&R), filed December 5, 2025, concerning Defendant's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint.

(See R&R, Dkt. No. 15.) Any party who desires to object to a Magistrate Judge's findings and recommendations must serve and file specific written objections within 14 days after being served with a copy of the findings and recommendations. FED. R. Clv. P. 72(b)(2). A copy of the R&R was mailed by certified mail on December 8, 2025, and received on December 11, 2025.

(See Dkt. No. 16.) Because no party has objected to the Magistrate Judge's findings or recommendations, the Court reviews the R&R for clear error. See *United States v. Wilson*, 864 F.2d 1219, 1221 (5th Cir. 1989); cf 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) ("A judge of the court shall make a de novo determination of those portions of the report or specified proposed findings or recommendations to which an objection is made.") After such review, the Court finds that the R&R is neither clearly erroneous nor contrary to law.

Accordingly, the Court ADOPTS the Magistrate Judge's R&R (Dkt. No. 15) and, for the reasons set forth therein, Defendant's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint (Dkt. No. 6) is GRANTED, and Plaintiff's claims are DISMISSED. This case is CLOSED. It is so ORDERED. SIGNED on January "1L, 2026. ORLANDO L. GARCIA United States District Judge
