SUMMARY

The Appellate Division, Third Department grants Lawrence B. Litwin’s application to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons. The court accepts his resignation, strikes his name from the roll of attorneys, prohibits him from practicing law in New York, and orders him to surrender any Attorney Secure Pass within 30 days.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether Litwin was eligible to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons under 22 NYCRR 1240.22(a).
2. Whether the court should grant the application, accept the resignation, strike Litwin's name from the roll of attorneys, and prohibit him from practicing law in New York.

HOLDINGS

1. Litwin was eligible to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons under 22 NYCRR 1240.22(a).
2. The application for permission to resign was granted and Litwin's nondisciplinary resignation was accepted; his name was stricken from the roll of New York attorneys, he was prohibited from practicing law in New York, and he was required to surrender any Attorney Secure Pass within 30 days.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Lawrence B. Litwin was admitted to practice in New York by the Appellate Division, Third Department, in 1981 and maintained a business address in Morristown, New Jersey. He sought permission to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons, and the Attorney Grievance Committee did not oppose the application.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Litwin submitted an affidavit sworn to April 21, 2026, and filed April 22, 2026. After considering the affidavit and the Attorney Grievance Committee's April 28, 2026 response, the Appellate Division determined that he was eligible to resign for nondisciplinary reasons and granted the application.
