SUMMARY

The Fourth Court of Appeals of Texas denied the State's motion to consolidate this criminal appeal with other cases. The court granted the State an extension of time to file its appellee's brief, setting January 6, 2023, as the deadline.

The State may file the same brief in multiple cases, if it so desires, by placing all appellate cause numbers in the style and by filing the brief separately in all cause numbers.
