SUMMARY

The Fourth Court of Appeals of Texas, San Antonio, granted court reporter Herminia Torres's second request for an extension to file the reporter's record. The court ordered the record filed by May 31, 2022, and stated that further extension requests would be disfavored.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the court reporter should receive a second extension of time to file the reporter's record.

KEY QUOTATIONS

“The request is GRANTED. Ms. Torres is ORDERED to file the reporter’s record with this court no later than May 31, 2022.” (Order)

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The court reporter had not completed the reporter's record by the deadline previously set by the court of appeals. The reporter requested a second extension of time, citing the late completion of the record. The appellate court granted the extension and ordered the reporter to file the record by May 31, 2022.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The appeal arose from the 226th Judicial District Court of Bexar County, Texas, trial court cause number 2020CR2612. On April 12, 2022, the court of appeals ordered the court reporter to file the reporter's record by May 2, 2022. After the reporter filed a notification of late record and requested a second extension, the court granted the request and extended the filing deadline to May 31, 2022.
