In re Complaint as to the Conduct of Phillips

SUMMARY

The Oregon Supreme Court reviewed disciplinary charges against Norman A. Phillips arising from a trust-review program conducted with insurance agents. The court found violations involving misrepresentations, disclosure and use of client secrets, and a conflict of interest, and suspended Phillips from practicing law for 36 months.
