SUMMARY

This document is a consanguinity chart used in probate to determine heirship and intestate succession for a decedent's estate. It visually maps familial relationships across six generations, from great-great-grandparents to grandchildren, identifying degrees of kinship such as first cousins and nieces/nephews. The chart serves as a reference tool for establishing the legal heirs under applicable probate law.
