1. Whether the appellant's contention concerning the font used in the order appealed from was properly before the Appellate Division.
2. Whether the Family Court order dismissing the petition as to Giovanni P. should be affirmed.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion concerns related child-protection proceedings under Social Services Law § 384-b. Following a hearing, the Family Court dismissed the petition as to subject child Giovanni P. Giovanni appealed from that order and also challenged the font used in the order.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Coalition for Hispanic Family Services commenced related proceedings under Social Services Law § 384-b in Family Court, Queens County. After a hearing, Family Court dismissed the petition as to Giovanni P. Giovanni appealed, and the Appellate Division affirmed.
