SUMMARY

The Supreme Court denied certiorari in this case from the Supreme Court of Nevada, leaving the state court's decision undisturbed. The per curiam order does not address the merits of the underlying dispute. This case is relevant for indexing procedural denials of review and the finality of state court judgments.
