SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio grants the parties' joint motion to remand a Social Security action. The court reverses the Commissioner's decision under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) and remands the matter for further administrative proceedings.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the district court should reverse the Commissioner's decision and remand the action under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for further administrative proceedings.

HOLDINGS

1. The court may reverse the Commissioner's decision under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) and remand the action to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings, and the court granted that relief here.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion concerns judicial review of a decision by the Commissioner of Social Security. The parties agreed that the matter should be remanded to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings. The court granted the requested sentence-four remand.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The action challenged a decision of the Commissioner of Social Security. The parties jointly requested that the district court reverse the Commissioner's decision and remand for further administrative proceedings, and the court granted that request.

DISPOSITION

reversed_and_remanded

REMAND INSTRUCTIONS

The Commissioner's decision is reversed under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), and the case is remanded to the Commissioner for further administrative proceedings.
