SUMMARY

The First Court of Appeals of Texas granted the appellant's unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal. The court dismissed the appeal with each party bearing its own appellate costs, vacated its May 30, 2019 judgment, declined to withdraw its prior opinion, and dismissed all other pending motions as moot.

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant has filed an unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal. See TEX. R. APP. P. 10.3(a)(2), 42.1(a)(1). The parties have agreed that each will bear his or her own appellate costs. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(d). Accordingly, we grant the unopposed motion and dismiss the appeal. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), (d), 43.2(f). We further vacate our May 30, 2019 judgment. We do not withdraw our opinion issued on May 30, 2019. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(c) ("In dismissing a proceeding, the appellate court will determine whether to withdraw any opinion it has already issued."). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
