MEMORANDUM OPINION

We directed Appellant to file her brief and a motion requesting an extension to file the brief within 10 days of our notice. Appellant did not respond. See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(b), (c). We dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution for failure to file a brief. See TEX. R. APP. P. 38.8(a), 42.3(b)–(c), 43.2(f). We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
