SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the District of Minnesota adopted a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation recommending dismissal of Giovanni German Vasquez Rosales's habeas corpus petition. The petition was dismissed without prejudice, and the court declined to issue a certificate of appealability.
