Jones v. Eighth Jud. Dist. Ct.

The Supreme Court of Nevada considered Darryl L. Jones's proper-person petition for writs of mandamus and prohibition concerning a pre-filing injunction imposed by the district court. The court granted the petition and issued a writ of mandamus.

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QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the Nevada Supreme Court should grant Jones's petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition concerning the prefiling injunction imposed by the Eighth Judicial District Court.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The Eighth Judicial District Court imposed a prefiling injunction against Darryl L. Jones. Jones challenged that injunction by petitioning the Nevada Supreme Court for extraordinary relief. The Supreme Court granted the petition and issued a writ of mandamus, but the supplied docket text does not include the court's factual findings or legal analysis.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Jones filed a proper-person petition for a writ of mandamus or prohibition in the Nevada Supreme Court on June 3, 2013. The Supreme Court ordered the State to answer and to provide the district court order imposing the prefiling injunction, related hearing transcripts, and other pertinent documents. After the State answered and Jones filed a reply, the Supreme Court granted the petition and issued a writ of mandamus on July 3, 2014.
