Attorney Grievance Comm'n v. Jones

SUMMARY

The Supreme Court of Maryland granted the Attorney Grievance Commission’s motion to reinstate Gregory Wayne Jones and dismiss the disciplinary petition. The Court dismissed the petition filed on November 17, 2025, restored Jones to good standing, and permitted him to resume practicing law in Maryland.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

- Whether the Attorney Grievance Commission's motion to reinstate Gregory Wayne Jones and dismiss the disciplinary petition should be granted.
- Whether Gregory Wayne Jones should be restored to good standing and permitted to practice law in Maryland.

HOLDINGS

1. The Supreme Court of Maryland granted the Attorney Grievance Commission's motion, dismissed the Petition for Disciplinary or Remedial Action, and restored Gregory Wayne Jones to good standing.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The Attorney Grievance Commission filed a Petition for Disciplinary or Remedial Action against Gregory Wayne Jones. The Commission subsequently moved for Jones's reinstatement and dismissal of the petition.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Attorney Grievance Commission filed a Petition for Disciplinary or Remedial Action on November 17, 2025. On February 4, 2026, the Commission moved to reinstate Jones and dismiss the petition, and the Supreme Court of Maryland granted the motion by order dated February 5, 2026.
