SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Central District of California issued an order to show cause regarding the parties' failure to file either a notice of settlement or a settlement status report after the required settlement conference. The court ordered the parties to explain by April 15, 2025 why sanctions should not be imposed and warned that failure to respond could result in sanctions or dismissal for lack of prosecution.

(See Dkt. 12, Court's Order of October 4, 2024, at 17). If the case settled, the parties were required to file a Notice of Settlement no later than 24 hours after settlement. (See id.). Otherwise, the parties were required to file a Status Report Re: Settlement no later than 48 hours after the settlement conference was complete. (See id.). As of the filing date of this Order, neither a Notice of Settlement nor a Status Report Re: Settlement has been filed. (See, generally, Dkt.). Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT, no later than April 15, 2025, the parties shall show cause in writing why sanctions should not be imposed for failure to comply with the Court's Order of April 4, 2025. Failure to submit a response to this Order by the deadline set forth above may result in the imposition of sanctions and/or dismissal of this action for lack of prosecution. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b); Link v. Wabash R.R. Co., 370 U.S. 626, 629-30, 82 S.Ct. 1386, 1388 (1962); Pagtalunan v.
