In re Amendments to Rule 25, Rules of the State Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters

2017 OK 79 (Okla. 2017) · Decided October 9, 2017

SUMMARY

The Oklahoma Supreme Court amended Rule 25 of the Rules of the State Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters. The amendment revised requirements for temporary permit applications and removed provisions concerning permit expiration and revocation; it became effective immediately.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether Rule 25 of the Rules of the State Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters should be amended as proposed.

2. When the amended Rule 25 should take effect.

HOLDINGS

1. Rule 25 of the Rules of the State Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters is amended in accordance with Exhibit A and the clean version in Exhibit B.
2. The amended Rule 25 is effective immediately.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The State Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters administers rules governing temporary permits for certified shorthand reporters. The court amended Rule 25 to require applicants for temporary permits to submit a completed application and supporting materials, require the Board to report its recommendation to the Chief Justice, and encourage professional development for temporary permit holders.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The matter came before the Supreme Court of Oklahoma for consideration of an amendment to Rule 25 governing temporary permits for certified shorthand reporters. The court adopted the amended rule and made it effective immediately.

Exhibit "A" Rules of the State Board of Examiners of Certified Shorthand Reporters Chapter 20, App. 1 Rule 25. Temporary Permits. A. In conjunction with the process outlined in 20 O.S. § 106.3B, Temporary permits to practice certified shorthand reporting until the conclusion of the next succeeding certified shorthand reporter (CSR) examination and report of the results thereof may be granted upon the recommendation of the Board after a showing of public convenience and necessity provided the applicant has not previously failed to complete satisfactorily the CSR examination.

All applicants for temporary permit shall file with the Board an properly completed application for temporary permit, along with any other supporting documents or information required by the Board. in addition to the regular application for the CSR examination.

The Board shall, as soon as practicable, report its recommendation on such application for temporary permit to the Chief JusticeSupreme Court, together with a copy of such application. B. Persons holding temporary permits are expected to work diligently toward building the speed and professional competence necessary to pass the CSR examination. Supervising judges are encouraged to support the professional development efforts of temporary permit holders, including providing access to a variety of docket assignments and allowing for mentorship from seasoned court reporters.

The temporary permit of any person who takes the CSR examination shall expire on the date that the successful applicants at that examination are enrolled provided that the temporary permit of
