FACTUAL BACKGROUND

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Gravady Nevada, LLC and CircusTrix, LLC appealed from proceedings in the Eighth Judicial District Court for Clark County, Nevada. After the appeal was referred to the settlement program and the parties failed to settle, the parties stipulated to dismissal without prejudice. The Supreme Court of Nevada dismissed the appeal and ordered the parties to bear their own costs and attorney fees.
