Jose Lozano v. State

SUMMARY

The Texas Court of Appeals for the Fifth District reinstated Jose Lozano's criminal appeal after adopting trial court findings concerning the delayed reporter's record. The court ordered the court reporter to file the complete record by February 2, 2015, and warned that failure to comply could result in an order barring her from sitting as a court reporter.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

- Whether the appeal should be reinstated after the trial court made findings concerning the delayed filing of the reporter's record.
- What deadline and consequences should govern the court reporter's filing of the overdue reporter's record.

HOLDINGS

1. The appeal was reinstated after the Court of Appeals adopted the trial court's findings.
2. The court reporter was ordered to file the complete reporter's record by 4:00 p.m. on February 2, 2015.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Appellant sought to pursue the appeal, was indigent, and was represented by appointed counsel who timely requested preparation of the reporter's record. The official court reporter, Belinda Baraka, attributed the delay to her workload and indicated that she needed forty-five days from the trial court's December 19, 2014 findings to file the record; the record was already four months overdue.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The appeal was previously abated after the appellate court ordered the trial court to make findings concerning the delayed reporter's record. After adopting the trial court's findings, the Court of Appeals reinstated the appeal and ordered the court reporter to file the complete reporter's record by February 2, 2015.

DISPOSITION

REMAND INSTRUCTIONS

The appeal was reinstated. Belinda Baraka was ordered to file the complete reporter's record by 4:00 p.m. on February 2, 2015. If the record was not filed by that deadline, the court stated that it would order her not to sit as a court reporter until the record was filed.

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
