SUMMARY

The Appellate Division, Fourth Department unanimously affirmed an Onondaga County Family Court order determining that Thomas M. neglected the subject child in a proceeding under Family Court Act article 10. The court affirmed without costs and adopted the same memorandum as in the related appeal, Matter of Akeem M. (Thomas M.).
