PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Rajwant Kaur appealed and Jaswinder Singh cross-appealed from proceedings in the Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County, case D323977. The Nevada Supreme Court heard oral argument on November 12, 2020, and issued an opinion on December 10, 2020, reversing and remanding. Rehearing and en banc reconsideration were subsequently denied, and remittitur issued on April 12, 2021.
