SUMMARY

The United States District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma adopts a magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation and dismisses the pro se plaintiff's complaint without prejudice. The dismissal is based on failure to follow court orders under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 42(b), and the plaintiff's failure to object waives appellate review.

ORDER Before the Court is Magistrate Judge Suzanne Mitchell's Report and Recommendation (Dkt. 6), recommending pro se Plaintiff's Complaint (Dkt. 1) be dismissed for failure to follow court orders pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 42(b).

Judge Mitchell advised Plaintiff of his right to object to the Report and Recommendation and that any failure to object would result in a waiver of the right to appellate review.¹ Plaintiff has filed no objection to the Report and Recommendation.² This Court has reviewed Magistrate Judge Mitchell's Report and Recommendation (Dkt. 6) and agrees with the reasoning and conclusions therein.

However, Plaintiff has not notified the Court of any changes in his address as required under Local Civil Rule 5.4. hereby ADOPTS the Report and Recommendation (Dkt. 6) in full.
