Matter of Mishkin

SUMMARY

The Appellate Division, Third Department granted Jeremy David Mishkin's application to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons. The court accepted his resignation, struck his name from the roll of attorneys, prohibited him from practicing law in New York, and ordered him to surrender any Attorney Secure Pass within 30 days.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether Jeremy David Mishkin was eligible to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons.
2. Whether the court should grant the application, accept the resignation, strike Mishkin's name from the roll of attorneys, and impose the associated restrictions and surrender requirement.

HOLDINGS

1. Mishkin was eligible to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons under 22 NYCRR 1240.22(a).
2. The application was granted and the nondisciplinary resignation was accepted; Mishkin's name was stricken from the roll, he was prohibited from practicing law or holding himself out as an attorney in New York, and he was required to surrender any Attorney Secure Pass within 30 days.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Jeremy David Mishkin was admitted to practice by the Appellate Division, Third Department, in 2012 and maintained a business address in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania with the Office of Court Administration. He sought permission to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons. He submitted an affidavit, the Attorney Grievance Committee did not oppose the application, and the court determined that he was eligible to resign.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Jeremy David Mishkin, who was admitted to practice by the Third Department in 2012, filed an application and supporting affidavit seeking permission to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons. The Attorney Grievance Committee advised that it did not oppose the application. The Appellate Division determined that Mishkin was eligible and granted the application.

Mishkin now seeks leave to resign from the New York bar for nondisciplinary reasons (*see* Rules for Atty Disciplinary Matters [22 NYCRR] § 1240.22 [a]). The Attorney Grievance Committee for the Third Judicial Department (hereinafter AGC) advises that it does not oppose Mishkin's application.

Upon reading Mishkin's affidavit sworn to March 16, 2026 and filed April 2, 2026, and upon reading the April 24, 2026 correspondence in response by the Deputy Chief Attorney for AGC, and having determined that Mishkin is eligible to resign for nondisciplinary reasons, we grant his application and accept his resignation.

Pritzker, J.P., Ceresia, McShan, Powers and Ryba, JJ., concur.

ORDERED that Jeremy David Mishkin's application for permission to resign is granted and his nondisciplinary resignation is accepted; and it is further

ORDERED that Jeremy David Mishkin's name is hereby stricken from the roll of attorneys and counselors-at-law of the State of New York, effective immediately, and until further order of this Court (*see* generally Rules for Atty Disciplinary Matters [22 NYCRR] § 1240.22 [b]); and it is further

ORDERED that Jeremy David Mishkin is commanded to desist and refrain from the practice of law in any form in the State of New York, either as principal or as agent, clerk or employee of another; and Mishkin is hereby forbidden to appear as an attorney or counselor-at-law before any court, judge, justice, board, commission or other public authority, or to give to another an opinion as to the law or its application, or any advice in relation thereto, or to hold himself out in any way as an attorney and counselor-at-law in this State; and it is further

ORDERED that Jeremy David Mishkin shall, within 30 days of the date of this decision, surrender to the Office of Court Administration any Attorney Secure Pass issued to him.
