SUMMARY

The Texas Court of Appeals for the First District of Houston continued the abatement of the appeal pending finalization of the parties' settlement agreement. The court ordered the parties to file a motion or status report within 14 days and stated that the appeal remained abated and removed from the court's active docket.

If the parties do not respond as directed, the case may be reinstated on the Court's active docket and the appeal will proceed under the applicable Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure.
