ORDER

For the reasons stated in the accompanying memorandum opinion, it is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiffs' motion for a stay of agency action under 5 U.S.C. § 705, ECF 49, is GRANTED. It is further ORDERED that, to "preserve status or rights pending conclusion of the review proceedings," 5 U.S.C. § 705, the effective dates of implementation and enforcement of the seven-day notice policy laid out in Secretary Noem's January 8 memorandum, ECF 39-1, including as ratified by Secretary Noem's February 2 memorandum, ECF 55-1, are immediately postponed and stayed. It is further ORDERED that the temporary restraining order entered by the Court on February 2, 2026, ECF 52, is hereby dissolved. SO ORDERED. _____
