Commonwealth of Pennsylvania v. Raheem Slone

SUMMARY

The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania denied Raheem Slone's petitions for allowance of appeal in four consolidated cases (Nos. 76-79 EAL 2021) via a per curiam order. The order provides no substantive legal analysis or holdings, simply declining to review the Superior Court's decision. This case is relevant for indexing as a denial of allocatur, indicating the court's refusal to exercise discretionary review.
