The Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals sustained Tudor Cliage, LLC's appeal after the parties resolved their dispute and stipulated to judgment in favor of the appellant. The Board entered a consent judgment awarding \$9,518.85, inclusive of Contract Disputes Act interest, with no further interest payable.
