SUMMARY

The Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals sustained Guidehouse LLP’s appeal pursuant to the parties’ stipulation and agreement. The Board entered a consent judgment awarding Guidehouse \$724,179.21, inclusive of Contract Disputes Act interest.

- Whether the Board should enter judgment in favor of Guidehouse LLP based on the parties' stipulation and agreement.
- What monetary amount should be awarded to Guidehouse LLP as part of the consent judgment.

HOLDINGS

1. Pursuant to 41 U.S.C. §§ 7105(e) and 7108(b), and the parties' stipulation and agreement, the Board sustained the appeal and entered judgment in favor of Guidehouse LLP.
2. Guidehouse LLP was awarded \$724,179.21 as a consent judgment, inclusive of Contract Disputes Act interest.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The appeal arose from a dispute under Contract No. FA8207-24-D-0001. The parties resolved the dispute and stipulated to entry of judgment in favor of Guidehouse LLP. The Board awarded Guidehouse LLP \$724,179.21, inclusive of Contract Disputes Act interest.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Guidehouse LLP brought an appeal under Contract No. FA8207-24-D-0001. The parties resolved their dispute and jointly requested that the Board enter judgment for Guidehouse LLP. The Board sustained the appeal and entered a monetary consent judgment.
