SUMMARY

The Thirteenth Court of Appeals of Texas granted the parties’ joint motion to dismiss the appeal without reference to the merits. The court taxed costs against the party incurring them, declined to entertain a motion for rehearing, and ordered the mandate to issue immediately.

QUESTIONS PRESENTED

1. Whether the court should grant the parties' joint, unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal without reference to the merits.

HOLDINGS

1. The court granted the parties' joint and unopposed motion to dismiss the appeal without reference to the merits under Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 42.1(a)(1).

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

The opinion contains no substantive merits facts. The parties conferred and jointly agreed to request dismissal of the appeal without reference to the merits.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The appeal was taken from the 464th District Court of Hidalgo County, Texas. While the appeal was pending, the parties jointly requested dismissal, and the court of appeals granted the unopposed motion, taxed costs against the party incurring them, and directed that the mandate issue immediately.
