Breton Insurance Agency Inc v. Secura Insurance Company

No. SC: 158197, Michigan Supreme Court (April 30, 2019)

SUMMARY

The Michigan Supreme Court denied leave to appeal in this insurance agency dispute, leaving the Court of Appeals judgment intact. The case involves Breton Insurance Agency, Inc. against Secura Insurance Company, arising from Kent County Circuit Court (No. 16-000581-CB). The order is per curiam, with no substantive ruling on the merits.
