- Whether Plaintiff's motion for service should be granted and service of the complaint should be effected without prepayment of fees and costs.

HOLDINGS

- The court granted Plaintiff's motion for service and directed the U.S. Marshal to serve the complaint and order on Defendant without prepayment of fees and costs or security.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

Plaintiff Kristie Sherrel Wiggins filed a complaint on June 4, 2026, and was previously permitted to proceed in forma pauperis. The court had deferred the issue of service and later considered Plaintiff's motion requesting service on Defendant Domatar.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The court previously granted Plaintiff leave to proceed in forma pauperis and deferred determination of service. Plaintiff then moved for service. The court granted the motion, directed the U.S. Marshal to serve the complaint and order on Defendant, and ordered Defendant to answer within twenty-one days after service.

Plaintiff to proceed in forma pauperis ECF No. 6.

The matter of service was to be determined at a later date. Id. The Court now GRANTS Plaintiff's Motion for Service (ECF No. 4) and directs the U.S. Marshal to serve a copy of the Complaint filed on June 4, 2026 (ECF No. 2) and a copy of this order on Defendant by serving the Defendant at the following address: DOMTAR 285 US 71 South Ashdown, AR. 71822 ` without prepayment of fees and costs or security thereof.
